At the end of January we collected and despatched four large boxes of baby clothes for refugees in Samos, Greece. Some very generous parishioners had bought new clothes to donate. However they have still not arrived, being stuck in a depot in France as far as I can tell, waiting for the charity in Samos to pay an import charge of 6035 Euros -

yes, six thousand and thirty five euros! Obviously that is way beyond their reach, and many many times the value of the clothes. Attempts to find out how this charge was arrived at, and even why humanitarian aid is taxed, have so far been unsuccessful.

Completing the customs declaration before sending was a nightmare, every item to be counted, valued and identified with a tariff code from a complicated list of codes. This is a direct result of the current trade climate between the U.K. and the European Union because we have previously sent goods to Samos without problem.
