Opening Of St. Therese's Rhosneigr and St. Anne's, Menai Bridge

The times for Mass in five of our churches published in last week's newsletter have been confirmed.
The booking contacts are set out in this newsletter

In addition to the Mass times already published, there will be a "closed" service for St. Mary's School on Wednesdays at 10 a.m. It was felt important to find a space and time for the "community" of the School and Staff to come together in Church for a Mass or Service. Because of the numbers that will be present it is not possible to accommodate anyone not working in the School.

It is proposed that we begin the process of reopening St. Therese's, Rhosneigr and St. Anne's, Menai Bridge. (St. Therese's Mass will be at 6p.m. replacing the Saturday evening mass at 6p.m. in Holyhead. This was what should have happened pre pandemic – but obviously could not be implemented.)

Both churches will reopen as soon as all the criteria are met.

This will depend on the Rhosneigr and Menai Bridge Communities agreeing to this, and if so – also agreeing:

- a/ Preparing the church with regard to social distancing, including appropriate signage, removal of hymn books, stationery etc. Agreeing the maximum places allowed under COVID 19 restrictions
- b/ Ensuring there are sufficient members of the community willing to act as volunteer stewards and cleaners (Please contact Fr. Frank or Fr. Joe as soon as possible if you wish to volunteer)
- c/ Obtaining the Bishop's permission to reopen.

All this will take some time and the Saturday evening Mass will continue in Holyhead until further notice.

These proposals will particularly affect the Holyhead, Rhosneigr and Menai Bridge communities, although the time and place of Saturday evening Mass is of interest to all the members of our seven faith communities, and we invite comments, thoughts and ideas over the next few weeks, as well as offers to volunteer as stewards and cleaners.

Nothing is set in stone until all those that wish to comment have had the opportunity to do so
