The three parish areas give the Island Mission steering groups £3000 per year (total £9000) to enable them to carry out their agreed objectives. In 2017 Administration group spent £350.84, Inculturation £305.78, Family Life / children's liturgy / Pastoral Development £637.29 and Adult Faith Development (liturgy training / knowledge and understanding / skills development) £5802.99
Total £7096.90. Carried forward £1903.10. The underspend was due to several courses being cancelled.
We also received a grant of £4750 from the Wrexham Concern Trust conditional on match funding from the parish levy. £2065 remains to be spent in 2018.
