**DAUGHTERS OF INVENTION PODCAST:** the last session is this Tuesday 18th June in the Parish hall at 7pm. It is direct from New York City— *Climate Change Week at the U.N. General Assembly*. Governments, diplomats, business leaders gather to assess progress, make commitments and push for solutions to avert the climate CRISIS and deliver on the goals of the Paris Agreement. The two presenters are Mary Robinson a former President of the Irish Republic and Maeve Higgins an Irish Comedienne. Tea, coffee and refreshments will be served. The meeting will finish at 8.30 prompt.
